<p><b>House Cabernet Sauvignon</b> Glass-\$5.00 / Bottle (750ml) -\$15.00</p> <p><b>House Merlot</b> Glass -\$5.00 / Bottle (750ml) -\$15.00</p> <p><b>Dumas Station Cabernet Sauvignon 2003</b> Bottle (750ml) -\$49.00 <i>Inaugural release of Dumas Station, it shows hints of cherry, plum, and currants, with exceptionally subtle tannins and a smooth finish.</i></p> <p><b>Dumas Station Cabernet Sauvignon 2008</b> Bottle (750ml) -\$44.00 <i>Shows much more varietal character than the 2003 release.</i></p> <p><b>Waterbrook Melange Noir 2006</b> Bottle (750ml) -\$19.00 <i>Cinnamon, spice, and cherries with nuances of oak are welcomed into a bright palate of delicious rich berries, pepper, and chocolate, finishing with lively enthusiasm.</i></p> <p><b>Couvillion Cabernet Sauvignon 2004</b> Bottle (750ml) -\$34.00 <i>Couvillion's first vintage of their flagship wine, Cabernet Sauvignon, brings aromas of bing cherry, black plum, and spice. The wine is rich and robust, with silky textures and soft tannins. Well balanced and elegant.</i></p> <p><b>Couvillion Merlot 2006</b> Bottle (750ml) -\$33.00 Columbia Valley hand chosen berries.</p> <p><b>Louis Jadot Beaujolais Villages (France)</b> Bottle (750ml) -\$16.50 <i>A classic Beaujolais, it should pair well with any of our less spicy offerings.</i></p>	<p><b>Sky River Sweet Mead</b> Bottle (750ml) -\$23.00 <i>Nectar of the gods. Sky River Sweet Mead enjoys a lingering full honey body. The intricate notes of the flowers and fruits that prelude the making of the honey are richly represented. Reminiscent of a fine German Riesling.</i></p> <p><b>Canoe Ridge Vineyard Dry Rose</b> Bottle (750ml) -\$15.00 <i>Made primarily from Horse Heaven Hills Cabernet Sauvignon. Strawberry &amp; peach fruit flavors with notes of toffee.</i></p>

### SuLei Cellars 2008 Roussanne

Bottle (750ml) -\$25.00

*This dry style Roussanne displays pretty notes of orange blossom and citrus followed by mouthwatering pineapple and Golden Delicious apples. Nuances of baking bread round out the crisp acidity and rich mouthfeel of this selection. The grapes are from the foothills of the Blue Mountains on the Oregon side of the Walla Walla AVA. It is 100% Roussanne. Fermented in stainless steel and aged on neutral French oak for about 3 months before bottling.*

### L'Ecole Fries Vineyard Sémillon 2005

Bottle (750ml) -\$27.00 (Almost sold out)

*This crisp and viscous wine shows its marvelous honey, peach, pear and apricot flavors, with spicy floral and honeysuckle aromas and hints of fresh fig, kiwi and apple on a lemon-zesty finish.*

### L'Ecole Columbia Valley Sémillon 2008

Bottle (750ml) -\$18.25

*Remarkably brilliant with rich fruit and balance acidity, this wine shows fragrant citrus blossom, lemon and floral aromas, with melon, pear, lychee nut and key-lime flavors on a honeysuckle mineral-rich finish.*

### Waterbrook Pinot Gris 2007

Bottle (750ml) -\$15.00

*Fresh cut grass and tropical aromas fill the fragrant nose. Bright acidity with lemon zest, ripe mango and cantaloupe make your mouth water. A clean finish rounded out with a nice mineral and gooseberry flavors.*

### Couvillion Sauvignon Blanc 2007

Bottle (750ml) -\$32.00

This wine expresses pear, pineapple, kiwi, and citrus aromas with a hint of floral notes.

### L'Ecole Chenin Blanc Columbia Valley 2009

Bottle (750ml) -\$20.00

*This fresh, tart and delightfully fruity Chenin Blanc shows Asian pear, perfumed honeysuckle and orange blossom aromas with flavors of apple, apricot and grapefruit on a crisp mineral, lightly sweet finish.*
