House Cabernet Sauvignon

Morrison Lane Syrah 2004

Bottle (750ml) -\$25.00

Walla Walla wine. A fruity, powerful Syrah.

Dumas Station Cowcatcher Red 2009

Bottle (750) - \$34.00

TA blend of four Bordeaux varietals with a dash of Syrah, this wine was crafted with free-run juice to produce deep fruit flavors. These flavors include dark cherries, tobacco, green olives, and a hint of blackberries. Dark tea, notes of leather, and subtle tannins round out this full-bodied Walla Walla wine.

Waterbrook Melange Noir 2006

Bottle (750ml) -\$21.00

Cinnamon, spice, and cherries with nuances of oak are welcomed into a bright palate of delicious rich berries, pepper, and chocolate, finishing with lively enthusiasm.

Couvillion Sagemoor Cabernet Sauvignon 2008

Bottle (750ml) -\$34.00

A Bordeaux varietal has the flavors of fresh berries with hints of mocha and undertones of clove and ripe plums.

Couvillion Equilibre 2008

Bottle (750ml) -\$34.00

The aroma on this blend explodes with the essences of berries, plums, and Bing cherry. This medium bodied wine is balanced by complex notes of dark chocolate and spice.

Ecco Domani Chianti

Bottle (750ml) -\$16.00

Lively & fresh on the palate with soft, rounded tannin – an ideal complement to all types of pasta, red or white meats. 92% Sangiovese 8% Merlot.

Manon Tempranillo 2004

Bottle (750ml) -\$17.00

From the Castilla region of Spain. Three months aging in oak gives this wine a unique bouquet, a mix of berries, sweet spices, coconut, and cinnamon.

Canoe Ridge Vineyard Dry Rose

Bottle (750ml) -\$15.00

Made primarily from Horse Heaven Hills Cabernet Sauvignon. Strawberry & peach fruit flavors with notes of toffee.

Barnard Griffin Syrah Port

Bottle (500ml) -\$21.00

Just a whiff of chocolaty, toasty wood gives way to fabulous aromas of cherry and raspberry. Richly fruited and thickly layered, boasting a stylish streak of blueberry fruit.

Villa Giada Andrea Faccio Moscato D' Asti 2009

Bottle (750ml) -\$26.00

A light, lovely, low alcohol elixir that captivates the senses and captures the essence of the ancient Moscato grape.

L'Ecole Columbia Valley Sémillon 2008

Bottle (750ml) -\$18.25

Remarkably brilliant with rich fruit and balance acidity, this wine shows fragrant citrus blossom, lemon and floral aromas, with melon, pear, lychee nut and key-lime flavors on a honeysuckle mineral-rich finish.

Waterbrook Pinot Gris 2009

Bottle (750ml) -\$16.00

Fresh cut grass and tropical aromas fill the fragrant nose. Bright acidity with lemon zest, ripe mango and cantaloupe make your mouth water. A clean finish rounded out with a nice mineral and gooseberry flavors.

Couvillion Sauvignon Blanc 2007

Bottle (750ml) -\$32.00

This wine expresses pear, pineapple, kiwi, and citrus aromas with a hint of floral notes.

L'Ecole Chenin Blanc Columbia Valley 2009

Bottle (750ml) -\$20.00

This fresh, tart and delightfully fruity Chenin Blanc shows Asian pear, perfumed honeysuckle and orange blossom aromas with flavors of apple, apricot and grapefruit on a crisp mineral, lightly sweet finish.
